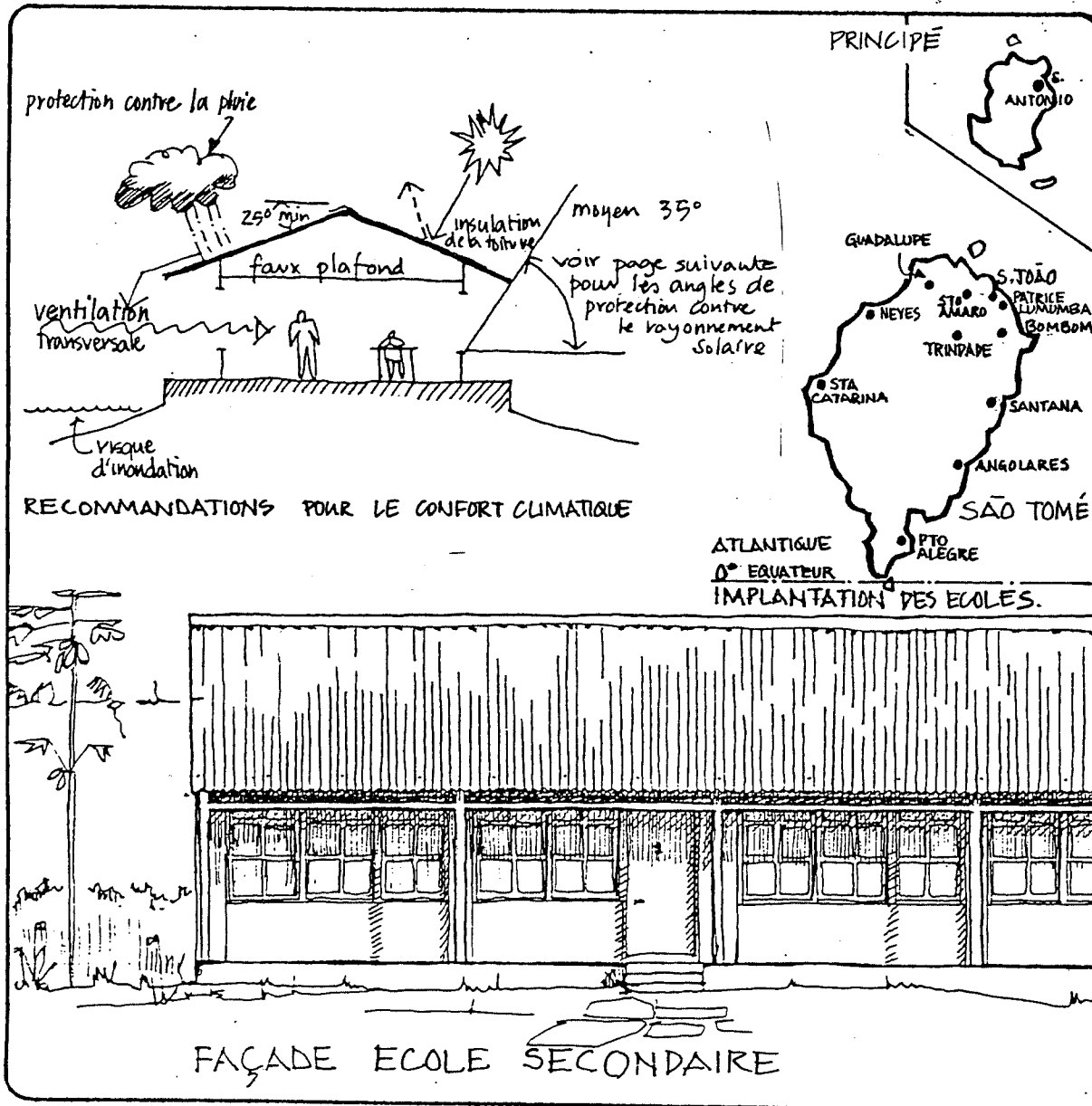

Development Workshop provided an architect for the UNESCO preparatory mission to Sao Tomé & Príncipe in 1983 for the organisation of a major secondary school construction project.

The project includes the extension of 6 existing schools and the construction of 6 new schools, providing a total of 4260 new pupil places. The programme included the sizing and location of the schools, as well as preparing the budgets, plans and specifications for the buildings.

Classrooms have been designed to meet local climate and physical conditions, and use local building materials, as national resources for bringing in materials from abroad are very limited.

Construction will be undertaken by local contractors, as will the manufacture of desks and chairs.

Total estimated cost of project is US \$ 14.8 Million, funded by the African Development Bank.
